DITEP Training in Clark County: Drug Impairment Training for Educational Professionals (DITEP) is a two-day training which teaches skills needed to identify chemically impaired individuals and types of drugs. **Chris Hollar** is attempting to bring this police-led training to Clark County.

Guiding Good Choices: GGC is a program designed to help parents communicate with their children about important topics such as drugs, alcohol, and tobacco. The Marshfield Clinic, UW-Stevens Point, and the CCPP are working together to bring this program to Clark County. This event will be held November 3rd, 10th, and 17th in the Neillsville Courthouse Auditorium (Room 101) from 6pm-8:30pm.

Coalition Expansion and Cross Pollination: We have some exciting opportunities to partner with other coalitions in Clark County. Members of the CCPP are currently invited to join and assist in activities with the Central Wisconsin Sexual Assault Response Team (Owen-Withee), Mental Health Task Force (Neillsville), and Drug Endangered Children (Neillsville).
