5:15 – RX Disposal Program - DOJ is now in charge of all take back events. Therefore, we are asking departments to hold onto their medications until DOJ sponsored take back events. There may also be an opportunity to purchase an additional component for the boxes. Boxes could then receive syringes as well as medications. A discussion was held to weigh the benefits of this addition and it was decided to table the item until a greater need for this addition existed.

5:20: Medical Marijuana is a question that many states are now considering. There are some legitimate medical uses for the active ingredient in marijuana but in its crude form it is no different than the illegal form.

5:26: AmeriCorps program into the coming years. We will be not renewing the position and this will potentially change the trajectory of the Partnership. Our role in the schools will be changing in the coming year. We are planning on supporting Rebecca and the YIA Coalition, but most of our support will be on a community involvement platform.

5:31: Future programs – Our coalition is looking to expand into the surrounding communities. We are looking to open up communication with key community members from each municipality.
